INTER- REGISTER REGULARITY RALLY
SUNDAY 19TH JULY 2009

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. The Alvis Register on behalf of the Inter Register Club will organise a Regularity/ Observation rally on Sunday 19th July 2009, the event being a round of the Inter Register Club Championship.
2. The routes will cover around 50 miles of interesting scenic motoring, with the morning section being a regularity run and after lunch there will be an observation section where clues have to be watched for by driver, navigator and passengers alike.
3. The regularity section will be based on any one of three nominated speeds-by the entrant- of 20 mph, 24 mph and 30 mph. This to be indicated on the entry form. Cars will leave the start control at 1 minute intervals. .
4. All observation clues can be seen from a slow moving car. No need to stop the vehicle and alight from same.
5. The Rally start point will be from the Moffatt House Hotel, High Street, Moffatt, DG10 9HL.
6. The event will be governed by the General Regulations of the RSAC Ltd and these supplementary regulations.
7. The RSAC will be issuing an exemption certificate for the event.
8. Detailed route instructions within rally pack will be given out at signing in on the Sunday morning and the competitors will encounter time controls at undisclosed points along the route. The event has been planned to be accessible and interesting for novice, expert crews and indeed the whole family. Note that route instructions will be self explanatory (eg straight on at cross roads will be S.O, left at T junction etc) and thus no navigational skills will be required.
9. The event is open to all pre 1941 cars entered by members of the Inter Register clubs together with other makes of cars manufactured before 1941.
10. Upon signing in, each entrant will receive a route pack with rally number for displaying on the front of the car.
11. By way of encouragement, competitors will be divided into 3 classes: (1) Experts, being those who have had class awards in a rally organised by the Inter Register Club or by the Vintage Sports Car Club, or other regularity rallies in the last 5 years, (2) Novices (who have not won!), and (3) Newcomer who will be on their first rally of this kind. Passengers/ families are most welcome! Awards will be presented as follows: Individual 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in both the morning and afternoon sections together with Best newcomer and team prize. A team will comprise 3 cars of a specific marque.
12. The rally will terminate at the Park Hotel, Peebles where afternoon tea/coffee can be purchased during the prize giving session.
13. Competitors are reminded that navigation equipment such as a "Halda Speed Unit" is not allowed., and the use of mobile phones or GPS devices would not be in the spirit of the event. They will not be needed in any case! Mechanical problems notwithstanding re a mobile phone of course!
14. Entry list opens with the issuing of the entry form and these regulations and closes on the 17th July 2009.
15. The maximum entry for the rally will be 30 cars with the minimum being 13. Should the minimum not be reached the organiser reserves the right to cancel the meeting and each entrant will be notified. A proportion of the rally fee will be retained to cover expenses incurred to date.
16. The rally fee covers the cost of the RSAC permit, together with administration / paperwork overheads and prizes/awards.

17. Per the normal practises of a regularity rally, penalty points will be accrued for being too early or too late at a control, missing a control , and likewise for the observation section penalties will awarded for not getting the correct answers to the questions.
18. Outline provisional programme:
 - 18.1 From 09.00 hrs cars assemble in the car park at front of the Moffatt House Hotel
 - 18.2 From 09.15 hrs Tea / coffee will be available in the hotel.
 - 18.3 From 10.00 hrs drivers to sign in and collect rally pack / route instructions.
 - 18.4 From 10.45 hrs first car will be flagged of and remainder at 1.0 minute intervals.
 - 18.5 Between 12.00 hrs to 14.00 hrs lunch break at scenic spot where snack / bar lunch can be purchased.
 - 18.6 On departure from lunch break each driver will receive their route instructions/ quiz sheet.
 - 18.7 15.00 hrs to 17.15 hrs cars will be arrive at destination for afternoon tea/coffee and prize giving

(above will be re-confirmed or otherwise nearer the date)

19. We have advised the Moffatt House Hotel that several of our entrants may wish to stay at the hotel on the Saturday night. The current rate is £99 B& B for a double / twin room, or £69 for a single room B&B. For those that are staying in the area for the weekend, we are hoping to have a get together meal during the Saturday night in the Moffatt House hotel. The 3 course dinner will cost £25 per head. The tea/coffee and shortbread on Sunday morning will £2.95 per head. The hotel is a listed building with Ivy clad walls and was built as a mansion for the Earl of Hopetoun in the 1750's . It is part of the Best Western Group. It only has 20 rooms and at time of writing three are already booked! So if you are thinking of staying in Moffatt we would recommend you move fast Tel No is 01683 220 039. Just mention the Alvis vintage car rally.
Another hotel in Moffatt is the Annandale Arms Hotel, also in the high street and the rates are slightly less at £95 for double /twin room but does not have the classical Georgian style of the above. Tel No is 01683 220013.
There are several other small hotels in the town together with many B & Bs, and on the southern extremity there is a very well equipped camping and caravan site run by the "Camping and Caravan Club of Gt Britain" tel No 01683 220436.
20. All entries will be acknowledged.
